6. PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION:

- a. **Case Z-02-11 Brent McEuen, Rezone Request R1-6 to AR.** Applicant is requesting a rezone from R1-6 (Single Family Residential) to A-R (Agricultural Residential) on one acre of property located behind 471 W. 20th St., Graham County Parcel # 103-08-266. Brent McEuen, requests to rezone one acre of the property to A-R to utilize the allowable uses in an Agricultural Residential District. The Section 17.40.10 of the Safford Municipal Code states:

The purpose of this zoning district is to represent those areas of the community set aside especially for families wishing to maintain a few head of livestock in an otherwise residential environment. In order to protect the health of the zone's inhabitants and to prevent the emission of excessive odor and dust, limitations as to the number of animals are requested. It can be expected that a certain amount of odor and dust will be present, and the people who choose to live in this zone should bear this in mind.
