Need a GED? The Safford Library can help!

The Safford City-Graham County Library has continued its GED Adult Education Prep Program which began in the summer of 2017. There are currently 24 students registered in the program. This free online program is already a big success in helping our citizens prepare for taking the GED test. Students qualify for the program if they are 16 years or older, not currently enrolled in any other GED support or service and not currently enrolled in school or out of school for more than 3 months. Students may register for the program or receive more information at the library front desk located at 808 S 7th Avenue, Safford.

Give From the Heart Update

Throughout 2017 the Business Service and Field Service Departments have done several things to raise money for the elderly in the community that are in need. They have gone to local businesses to ask for partnerships to continue this program and have received many donations. In addition, they have held fundraisers throughout the year including a hot dog sale, bake sales and raffles. Several grants have been applied for with the Give from the Heart Program receiving a \$2,500 grant from the Arizona Community Foundation and \$10,000 from United Way of Graham & Greenlee Counties. Over \$30,000 was raised this past year. Anyone can donate to the program: simply mark the box on your payment stub with the desired amount to donate. Thank you to all who have donated to this program through your monthly utility bill payments. The Business Service and Field Service Departments are continuing to look for more ways to grow the program and to continue raising funds in order to be able to assist the elderly in subsidizing a portion of their utility bill monthly.
