Reminder for Safford Residents: You may dump one free load of residential trash per month at the Safford Landfill. A drivers license and current utility bill are required to provide proof of residency.

Please tarp or secure your loads to avoid an additional fee and to help keep the road to the Landfill clean of debris.

SANITATION TIPS & INFORMATION

The Sanitation Division picks up all residential and most commercial trash within city limits, totaling approximately 3700 customers.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Trash containers must be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on day of scheduled pick up. **All** trash must be containerized, bundled or bagged when placed in the container.
- The city of Safford offers a free weekly bulk pickup, not to exceed 4 cubic yards, to residential Sanitation customers.
- Garbage shall be placed completely in the sanitation container but not overfilled.

Green Waste:

Green waste, i.e. grass, leaves, plant trimmings, and prunings shall be placed in thirty (30) gallon plastic bags, boxes or bagged if placed in the sanitation container(s). Tree branches must be tied in bundles not to exceed four (4) feet in length and forty (40) pounds

Appliances and Vehicles:

The City will collect discarded push lawn mowers and household tools from residences. This service must be requested by residential customers; the Sanitation Department will schedule collection, which normally does not exceed two (2) weeks.

Abandoned or discarded automobiles, motorcycles, scooters and motorized vehicles shall be disposed of by the property owner from private property or public right-of-way.

The Landfill does not accept appliances that have not been emptied of refrigerant and certified as so (tagged). **Sanitation will not pick up a refrigerating appliance unless it is tagged 'freon free' by a certified company.**

Building Materials:

Building material is not permitted in containers. Soil, concrete, bricks, concrete blocks, or fragments, aggregate, stone or bituminous concrete will not be collected by the City; this must be hauled by the contractor, owner or resident.
