## FAQ: *I need to call in a blue stake before I start my construction project.*

The City of Safford does not call in blue stakes for residents; we only mark them. Before you begin a construction or digging project of any kind, be sure to call the official Blue Stake number at 1-800-STAKE-IT and they will contact all utility and/or communications for that area. Blue stakes are not limited only to water, gas, and electric, they also include traffic lights/signals, railroad, cable, internet and fiber optic lines. Call before you dig!
