The Safford Police Department was recently awarded \$20,000.00 for DUI and Selective Traffic Enforcement from the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety. This Grant funding will provide overtime hours for Officers conducting traffic enforcement details, particularly around the holidays when traffic numbers are at their highest. In addition, the GOHS provided \$914.00 for the purchase of 2 Portable Breathalyzer Testers (PBTs).
