

RESOLUTION NUMBER 13-014

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAFFORD, GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA RATIFYING RATE SCHEDULES FOR THE PROVISION OF ELECTRIC UTILITY SERVICES EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2007, AS ATTACHED FOR RESIDENTIAL SERVICE, GENERAL COMMERCIAL SERVICE, LARGE COMMERCIAL DEMAND SERVICE, AND PURCHASE POWER ADJUSTMENT.

WHEREAS, The City of Safford owns and operates the Safford municipal electric system (*City of Safford Municipal Code 13.08.020*); and,

WHEREAS, The City desires that customer revenues support all current and projected operational and capital expenses of the systems; and,

WHEREAS, *Arizona Revised Statutes §9-511.01* and the *City of Safford Municipal Code §13.04.140* authorize the City Council to set rates for utility services by resolution; and,


WHEREAS, electric rates became effective beginning May 1, 2007, and is subject to future review by the Safford City Council; and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Safford, Graham County, Arizona, electric utility rates are ratified, adopted and hereby adjusted as follows:

1. Rates Schedules for **ELECTRIC UTILITY SERVICES** are hereby ratified and effective May 1, 2007 Residential Service, General Commercial Service, Large Commercial Demand Service, and Purchas Power Adjustment as attached and incorporated herein.
2. All previous resolutions, rules and regulations previously adopted concerning procedures, fees, surcharges and multipliers as presently constituted and which can be applied consistently with the Electric Utility rates, are hereby ratified and affirmed.





**RATE SCHEDULE - ER
RESIDENTIAL SERVICE
EFFECTIVE May 1, 2007**

AVAILABILITY

This rate schedule is available in all territory served by the City of Safford.

APPLICATION

For service to single residences and individual family apartments. Service shall not be resold or shared with others. In those existing cases where two or more family dwelling units are served through a single meter, all provisions of the rates shall be applied as though each dwelling unit had been separately metered.

TYPE OF SERVICE

The type of service provided under this schedule will be single phase service, at a single standard voltage of 120 or 120/240 volts.

RATES

The customer's bill shall be computed at the following rates plus any adjustments incorporated in this schedule:

Customer Charge	\$9.00	Per month
	\$0.29593	Or per day
Energy Charge	\$0.0935	Per kWh / All kWh

MINIMUM BILL

No Monthly bill shall be less than the customer charge.

RATE SCHEDULE - EC
GENERAL COMMERCIAL SERVICE
EFFECTIVE May 1, 2007

AVAILABILITY

This rate schedule is available in all territory served by the City of Safford.

APPLICATION

For service to single commercial establishments whose demand is, or has been, 30 kW or less during the preceding eleven months. Where a portion of a residential unit is used for non-residential purposes, the appropriate commercial rate schedule shall be applicable for all service. Service shall be through a single delivery point for each utility and shall not be resold without written agreement with the City of Safford Utilities.

TYPE OF SERVICE

The type of service provided under this schedule will be single phase service, at a single standard voltage of 120 or 120/240 volts.

RATES

The customer's bill shall be computed at the following rates plus any adjustments incorporated in this schedule:

Customer Charge	\$12.00	Per month
	\$0.3945	Or per day
Energy Charge	\$0.1000	Per kWh / All kWh

MINIMUM BILL

No Monthly bill shall be less than the customer charge.

**RATE SCHEDULE – ECLD
LARGE COMMERCIAL DEMAND SERVICE
EFFECTIVE May 1, 2007**

AVAILABILITY

This rate schedule is available in all territory served by the City of Safford.

APPLICATION

For service to single commercial establishments whose monthly usage for three consecutive months is greater than 30 kW. Where a portion of a residential unit is used for non-residential purposes, the appropriate commercial rate schedule shall be applicable for all service. Service shall be through a single delivery point for each utility and shall not be resold without written agreement with the City of Safford Utilities.

TYPE OF SERVICE

The type of service provided under this schedule will be single phase or poly phase service, at a standard voltage as required by customer.

RATES

The customer's bill shall be computed at the following rates plus any adjustments incorporated in this schedule:

Customer Charge	\$50.00	Per month
	\$1.6393	Or per day
Demand Charge	\$10.00	Per kW / All kW
Energy Charge	\$0.0660	Per kWh / All kWh

MINIMUM BILL

No monthly bill shall be less than the billing demand charge plus the customer charge.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The customer's capacity requirement shall be the maximum measured kilowatt demand occurring during any fifteen minute interval during the billing period, provided however for billing purposes such demand requirements shall not be less than 80% of the demand requirement during any of the eleven (11) preceding months. Meters for measuring the maximum capacity requirements over a fifteen-minute period shall be installed by the City of Safford Utilities.

ADJUSTMENT SCHEDULE - PPA
PURCHASE POWER ADJUSTMENT
EFFECTIVE May 1, 2007

APPLICATION

The current monthly bill, as calculated under any rate schedule requiring the measurement of kilowatt-hour consumption shall be increased or decreased in directed proportion to the "Purchase Power Adjustment." The Purchase Power Adjustment is computed by subtracting the current base charge from the 12-month weighted rolling average power costs.
