

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 12-008**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAFFORD, GRAHAM COUNTY, ARIZONA, STATING THE SALARY EQUIVALENCY AND THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED POSITIONS FOR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS AND RESERVE POLICE OFFICERS IN THE CITY OF SAFFORD, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-002.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 23-901(5)(d) of *Arizona Revised Statutes* provides that the governing body of a City shall establish a salary equivalency for workers compensation, premium payments, and compensation benefits for Reserve Police Officers and Volunteer Firefighters serving on a part-time basis without pay; and,

**WHEREAS**, Resolution Number 11-002 is therefore rescinded; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the salary equivalent for volunteer firefighters and reserve police officers for the City of Safford is in accordance with the average monthly wage statutory maximum amount as adopted by the Industrial Commission of Arizona (A.R.S. §23-1041(8)(e)) for purposes of premium payments and compensation benefits under the workers compensation, to be effective January 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year.

Section 2. That the number of volunteer firefighter(s) positions is thirty (30) and the number of volunteer reserve police officers is one (1) for coverage by industrial insurance and workers compensation.
