The following improvements have recently been made as part of the Dry Lake Capital Improvement Project:

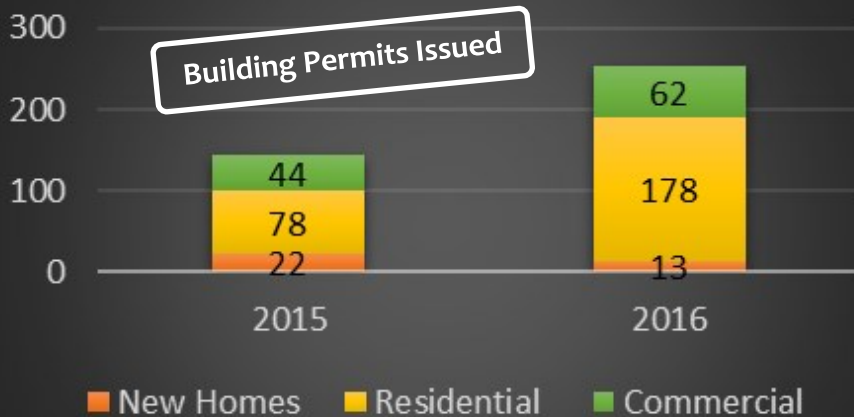
- Awning installed at Small Bore Range
