DOG OWNERS IN SAFFORD

Did you know, per our City Code, all dogs in Safford are to be annually registered through the City Clerk's Office?

Why should you register your dog?

- * Dog licensing is one way to ensure that all dogs who share our community receive rabies vaccinations.
- * A license is proof of ownership in case your dog is lost or stolen.
- * Wearing a license tells everyone that your pet is not a homeless stray and belongs to someone who legally registered their pet.

Just bring in your proof of rabies vaccination issued by a veterinarian and payment of \$10.00 for spayed or neutered and \$25.00 if not. Only 3 dogs (older than 6 months) are permitted per residence. Call 928-432-4005 if questions.
